Major Stegall, born February 8, 1927, died peacefully September 3, 2009, at the Harris Hospice Unit in Presbyterian Hospital. Jim lived his entire life in Charlotte except while serving his country in the US Navy during WW II. Some of his accomplishments including being the first to be promoted to the rank of Major in the Charlotte Police Department before his retirement in 1965, serving as a Charlotte City Councilman and on many civic boards and charitable organizations. He spent 20 years in a family owned security company before his third career began in the management business in 1990 where he worked each day until he became unable in June, 2009. He was a member of the East Gate Masonic Lodge, a 32nd degree Scottish Rite Mason and a Life Member of Oasis Shriners. He spent over 50 years serving the Shrine Bowl of the Carolinas.

He is survived by his faithful and loving wife Alys M. Stegall and was married for 59 years. His children include son Harry and wife Joanne, daughter Lynn and her husband Keith, grandchildren Baxter and wife Brittany, James, Kristopher, Taylor and Cole.
